Good afternoon,

Further to our earlier telephone conversation please see link to fishing in Cardiff Bay. Please ignore any reference to Jon Taylor as he no longer works for the Council.

With regard to fishing in Roath Park my colleague has provided me with the attached documents and the following information.

In response to your enquiry, I can confirm that Fishing is permitted at Roath Park Lake.

'Parkwood Leisure' , who are an external provider that manage the contract for operating the boat hire service (& collection of fishing income), are **not** currently collecting fees for fishing, until such time that they return to site (provisionally next Spring in 2021) and they re-open the boat hire service. May I suggest that you print off a copy of this e mail as proof of dispensation until such a time Parkwood return to site or the Council inform you of any change.

Anyone who attends site to fish, **must** have a current rod licence prior to commencement of any fishing.

For your information I have attached 2 documents both relating to this activity on Roath Park Lake. Please note that Cardiff Council do **not** issue a rod licence, *Natural Resource Wales* (see attached document) provides this relevant information. A copy of the Parks fishing regulations are also attached.

I hope this information is of some assistance but if you have any further queries please do not hesitate to contact me again.
